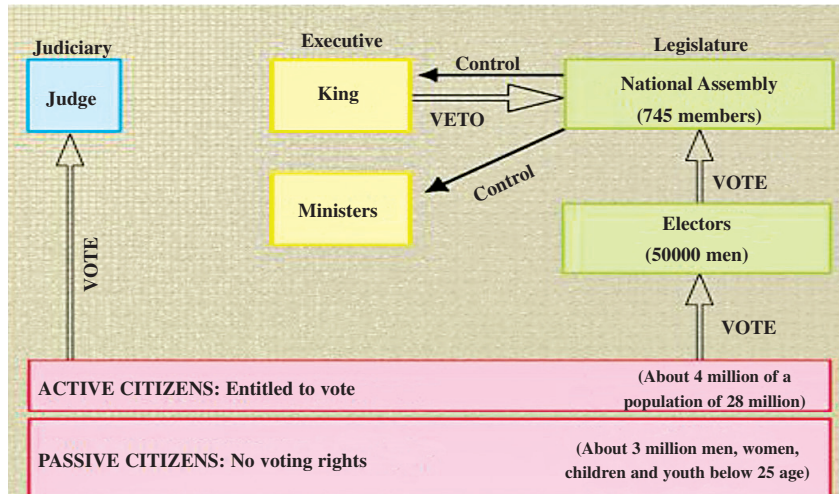
11. a) 'When the emergence of nation states the dominance of Aristocracy declined and middle class increased'. Do you agree with the statement. Give reasons.

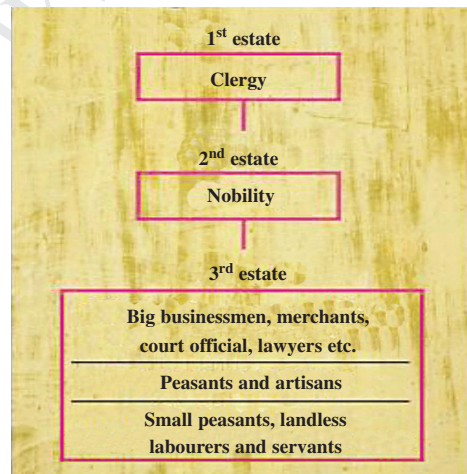


The political system under the constitution of 1791
